BASIC RIDER COURSE (BRC)

Designed for someone who has minimal experience operating a motorcycle, this course focuses on the development of basic riding skills: turning, shifting and braking. You will receive approximately 16 hours of instruction, four (4) in the classroom and 12 on the range. Training bikes will be provided. This course is offered in different formats: one (1) weekend, two (2) weekend, weekday and weeknight. The weekday, weeknight or two (2) weekend courses are recommended for novice riders. Successful completion allows a student to waive the Secretary of State riding skills test.

WHO SHOULD TAKE THIS MOTORCYCLE SAFETY COURSE?

- ▶ Those who want to learn to ride safely and are able to ride a two-wheel bicycle.
- ▶ Those who fail the State riding skills test twice.
- ▶ Students under the age of 18 are allowed to take this course starting at age 15 if they have a valid driver's license. A parent or guardian must accompany the student to the first class meeting; parent signatures are required on some documents. *Please note: The completion card received is only valid for one year from the issue date.*
