This course is designed to provide officers with the fundamentals of evidence processing and the skills necessary to properly investigate a crime scene. - Collection/Preservation of Evidence
- Crime Scene and Evidence Photography
- Latent Prints
- Footwear/Tire Impressions
- DNA, Blood splatter Interpretation, and Serology
- Hairs/Fibers
- Trace, Hit/Run, Paint, Arson, Footwear, and Tire Track Evidence
- Firearms, Tool mark, and Physical Match
- Cause and Manner of Death
- Two full days of solving Mock Crimes

Crime scene camera, including flash (*Please bring owner's manual and batteries/charger for camera and flash*), tripod, PC cord, filters, etc. flashlight, 3-4 of each type of evidence bags your police department uses.
