THREAT PATTERN RECOGNITION INSTRUCTOR- COURSE: FIREARMS (OFFICER SAFETY)

COURSE Date: **February 12—14, 2018**

TIME: **8:00am to 4:00 pm**

Human Factors Research Group (HFRG) has developed a Firearms Threat Pattern Recognition (TPR) program. The goal of this course is to enhance the speed of an officer recognition and response time by teaching the micro-movement threat indicators. The course focuses on biology-based response subsequent to time, distance and cover in life and death encounters with armed assailants. This course was designed from a TPR study that took 5 years to complete. The Firearms TPR study showed during a startled response firearms attack, all 58 officers who participated were wounded, with the officer accuracy rate of returning fire at 29.7%. After attending the Firearms TPR course, the officer's first exposure to a startled response attack reduced the number of officers wounded to 31 out of 58, with an officer accuracy rate of 78.7%. After the third exposure the number of officers wounded was down to 1 out of the 58, with an officer returning fire accuracy of 93.8%. This course is to supplement and enhance existing department firearms programs. This course is not designed to replace agencies existing firearms courses.
