

<b>Semesters Covered</b> .....	Fall 2013 & Winter 2014
<b>Award Amount</b> .....	Varies from \$500 to \$1500 annually (\$250-\$750 per semester)
<b>Enrollment Required</b> .....	Six (6) or more credit hours per semester
<b>Award Available</b> .....	For tuition, fees and books
<b>Renewal</b> .....	Non renewable—must apply each academic year
<b>First Priority Deadline Date</b> .....	<b>May 3, 2013</b>

Scholarships will be awarded until funds are exhausted

### Eligibility Criteria:

- Be a regularly admitted student at Schoolcraft College working toward a certificate or degree.
- Have a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.7 at the end of the winter 2013 semester.
- Make satisfactory academic progress according to the Schoolcraft College Academic Progress Policy for financial aid (obtain a copy from the Office of Financial Aid or online at [www.schoolcraft.edu/aid](http://www.schoolcraft.edu/aid)).
- Additional or special criteria, as determined by the individual scholarship, may be required.
- Must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov) prior to submitting this application for review.

### Additional Procedures:

- Complete the *Foundation Scholarship Application* which is available in the Office of Financial Aid, the Radcliff Main Office and online at [www.schoolcraft.edu/aid](http://www.schoolcraft.edu/aid).
- If you have completed fewer than 12 credit hours at Schoolcraft College, attach transcript copies from all high schools and colleges attended. Missing transcripts will prevent the scholarship application from being considered for an award.
- Submit completed scholarship application, with all applicable transcripts, to the Office of Financial Aid.

### Note:

- Generally students are limited to one Foundation scholarship per academic year.
- Students can only receive Foundation scholarship awards for a maximum of three years while attending Schoolcraft College.
- The application may be subject to review by the Schoolcraft College Foundation.
- Notification of award will be mailed to all applicants.
- Award recipients are expected to submit a Thank You letter to the donor of the scholarship.
