- Have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5 at the end of the winter 2013 semester.
- Make satisfactory academic progress according to the Schoolcraft College Academic Progress Policy for financial aid (obtain a copy from the Office of Financial Aid or online at www.schoolcraft.edu/aid).
- Have at least 26 earned credits from Schoolcraft College at time of application.
- Must be able to attend an interview with the Schoolcraft College Foundation. Interviews will be scheduled on Tuesday, June 18, 2013.
- Must complete FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) at www.fafsa.ed.gov prior to submitting this application for review.

Application Procedures:

- Submit completed scholarship application, with all applicable transcripts to the Office of Financial Aid by the deadline date.
- Applications are available in the Office of Financial Aid, the Radcliff Center Main Office and on-line at www.schoolcraft.edu/aid/scholarship.
- The application will be subject to review by the Schoolcraft College Foundation.
- Notification of award will be mailed to all applicants.
