- 2. Complete the Scholarship application on the reverse side. This application is for the Trustee Scholarship and the Award of Excellence. Qualifying students will automatically be considered for the higher scholarship amount. Students may not receive both scholarships.
- 3. Attach high school transcript (no student transcript i.e. Zangle) that shows your GPA from **9th grade through first semester or second trimester of senior year**.
- 4. Submit your ACT scores.
- 5. Submit all materials to the Admissions and Enrollment Center by March 29, 2013.
- 6. If you are offered the scholarship, you must reply to the Office of Financial Aid by the date on the Award Notification. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of the award.
