

## Class of 2012

Each year the College, in honor of the Board of Trustees, awards Trustee Scholarships to area high school seniors in recognition of academic achievement. These scholarships assist students in achieving their academic goals by making a quality education affordable. If you meet the following minimum criteria, please accept our invitation to apply for the Trustee Scholarship.

### Criteria

1. **Be a 2012 high school graduate.**
2. **Be admitted to Schoolcraft College.** Applying to the College is free! Apply for admission online at [www.schoolcraft.edu/apply](http://www.schoolcraft.edu/apply). Students who have attended Schoolcraft College under dual or special high school enrollment need to complete a new admission application. If you have questions, you may call the Admissions and Enrollment Center at 734-462-4426 or send an e-mail to [admissions@schoolcraft.edu](mailto:admissions@schoolcraft.edu).
3. **Have a minimum GPA of 3.0.** Your high school cumulative grade-point average (GPA) (not weighted) must be at least 3.0 by the end of the first semester or second trimester of your senior year.
4. **Have a minimum ACT composite score of 18.**

### Award Amount

\$1,500 per school year—\$750 Fall 2012 semester and \$750 Winter 2013 semester. Full-time (12+ credit hours per semester) attendance is required. No exceptions will be made.

### Renewal of Scholarship

The Trustee Scholarship is renewable for the fall and winter semesters of the next academic year for students who successfully complete 24 credit hours with a minimum Schoolcraft College GPA of 2.75 before the Spring 2013 semester.

### Award Deadline

**All materials must be received in the Admissions and Enrollment Center by March 30, 2012 to be considered.**

### Instructions

1. Apply for admission to Schoolcraft College at [www.schoolcraft.edu/apply](http://www.schoolcraft.edu/apply).
2. Complete the Trustee Scholarship application on the reverse side.
3. Attach a complete copy of your high school transcript that shows your GPA through the end of the first semester or second trimester of your senior year.
4. Submit your ACT scores. You may use your high school transcript if your ACT scores are recorded on it, have the scores sent to the college by ACT, or submit a copy of your test results.
5. Submit all materials to the Admissions and Enrollment Center.
6. If you are offered the scholarship, you must reply to the Office of Financial Aid by the date on the Award Notification. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiture of the award.
