## Basic Rider Course (BRC)

A 15-18 hour Motorcycle Safety Foundation course for the inexperienced rider. **Motorcycles are provided.** The State of Michigan riding skills test is waived for course graduates. To obtain your motorcycle endorsement you must take the written test & visual exam at the Secretary of State Office. **One-weekend courses are very demanding and not for the totally inexperienced student.** The **Weeknight/day** course is recommended for the inexperienced student and provides extra range time on basic skills.



## Performance Based Course (PB)

An 8-9 hour course for the experienced, but unlicensed, rider to become licensed and legal. Also, many experienced, licensed riders use the PB as an annual refresher and skills tune-up. **Students must provide their own motorcycle.** Scooters will be allowed in this class. The scooter must be titled and properly registered as a motorcycle in the student's name, and must display a valid motorcycle license plate. This course covers braking, turning, counter-steering, speed judgment, and other techniques. All students will take a riding skill evaluation at the beginning of class. If a student fails this evaluation, then he/she must enroll in the basic rider motorcycle course (BRC). Each student must provide proof of insurance for his/her bike and the bike must pass a safety inspection before the student may take the skills evaluation.

## Experienced Rider Course (ERC)

A 6-hour Motorcycle Safety Foundation course for the experienced licensed rider. Emphasis is on advanced riding skills. **Student must provide their own motorcycle.** All participants must provide proof of motorcycle endorsement, insurance for the motorcycle, and the motorcycle must pass a safety inspection.

## Class Schedules:

**One & Two-Weekend** classes run Friday night 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. and Saturday & Sunday, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

**Weekday** classes run 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. or 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., depending on location.

**Weeknight** classes run 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m.

**PB** classes run 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

**ERC** classes run 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Participants must be available to attend *all* scheduled times.

## **ALL STUDENTS MUST PROVIDE AND WEAR PROTECTIVE RIDING GEAR INCLUDING:**

**DOT-approved Motorcycle Helmet;** eye protection; full-finger gloves; sturdy, over-the-ankle boots — **NO TENNIS SHOES;** heavy-duty pants; heavy-duty long-sleeved shirt or jacket; and rain or cold weather gear as needed.
