### **Liberal Arts Transfer Program**

Liberal arts is a broad term that, at Schoolcraft College, encompasses anthropology, art, communications, English, foreign languages, history, humanities, music, philosophy, political science, sociology, theater and the honors program.

Students who choose to transfer to a four-year university in a liberal arts program often consider majors such as communications, psychology, public administration, or social work. They should follow very carefully the transfer guide from the college or university they wish to attend, and talk with a counselor frequently.

#### **Why Would I Choose LIBERAL ARTS as a Transfer Program?**

For students who are unsure of their major or who enjoy learning about a great many things, liberal arts offers a broad array of choices and a large measure of flexibility. Often, performing well in a university liberal arts program leads to a very good job. The student has proven his or her capacity to work hard, assimilate information, interpret facts, develop ideas and communicate clearly. Companies look for these qualities, then train the new hire in company-specific procedures.

#### **What Characteristics Do I Need To Work In This Field?**

A person who is comfortable in liberal arts has an insatiable curiosity, and wants a detailed knowledge of many things.

#### **Where Could I Find a Job?**

Liberal arts graduates are found in virtually every profession, at every level. A sound grounding in the liberal arts makes one an excellent candidate for a career in law, communication, public service, business or just about anything that interests you. Often liberal arts majors will go on to earn an advanced degree in a specific field.

#### **What Is My Employment Outlook?**

Job opportunities can be as broad as the liberal arts category itself. Some fields are hot, while others are static. Much depends on the field you choose and the part of the country where you chose to live.
