- Respond promptly to medical emergencies
- Respond promptly to trauma emergencies
- Determine patient's condition as well as pre-existing medical problems
- Attempt to stabilize the patient
- Transport patients to a hospital

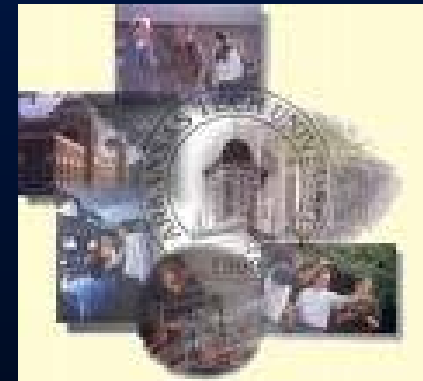
