PREPARE TO REGISTER

1. Set Up Your New Student Password

First Year Students

Transfer Students

Official college transcripts must be sent directly from the transfer institution to Schoolcraft College.

Request your transcript from your previous college at **getmytranscript.com**.

4. Submit Test Scores or Take a Placement Test

First Year Students

Have you taken the SAT or ACT within the last 3 years?

Yes: Request SAT scores at collegeboard.org and/or ACT scores at act.org/the-act/scores, or email your Score Report to admissions@schoolcraft.edu.

No: Make sure you have the most recent version of your high school transcript sent to Schoolcraft College then call Academic Advising, at 734 462-4429, to discuss your next steps. You may be required to take our placement test.

7. Register for Classes

- Get information on transfer and degree requirements.
- View student records, including billing statements, unofficial transcripts, and enrollment verifications.
