



What is SC EDGE?

In partnership with select high schools, Schoolcraft College offers the **SC EDGE—Earn a Degree, Graduate Early**—Early Middle College Program to provide high school students the opportunity to earn college credit and credentials while still in high school.

This unique program combines the flexibility of online learning with a structured and facilitated format. Classes are built into the student's high school schedule. Depending on the high school, a student may work on their college courses with other SC Edge students in a computer lab, or the high school may offer a more independent approach.

Who is eligible for SC EDGE?

All students must be in good academic and behavioral standing at their school. A grade point average of 2.5 is preferred. The students must exhibit a level of self-discipline and maturity as assessed by the high school counselor and/or the principal.

Interested students must meet with their high school counselor to discuss their interest and expectations of the program.

Steps to participate in SC EDGE

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Meet with Your High School Counselor
 Meet with your high school counselor to develop an educational plan and determine your eligibility under the public Postsecondary Enrollment Act. Ask about your enrollment eligibility, course selection, and any available funding for tuition, fees, and materials including books. Counselor signature and recommendation is required.
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Complete the SC EDGE Authorization Form
 Complete the SC EDGE Authorization Form and obtain all of the required signatures (parent, counselors, and principal).
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Complete the Online Application
 Complete the online application at schoolcraft.edu/apply.
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Complete Essay
 Upload a one-page typed essay to your completed application answering the following question:
Why do you feel you would be a good candidate for the SC EDGE Early College Program?
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Submit Required Documents
 Upload your SC Edge Authorization Form, your high school transcript, your essay, and your PSAT or ACT PLAN scores to your online application.
