

## COMMUNITY COLLEGE GUARANTEE PAYMENT POSTPONEMENT REQUEST

### *FOR 2026 HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES ONLY*

This form is for students who have had a completed 2026-27 FAFSA sent to Schoolcraft, and want to register for Fall 2026 classes, but have a future 2026 High School graduation date scheduled prior to August 31, 2026.

**This form will NOT be accepted and a payment postponement will NOT be placed on the account if you do not have a completed FAFSA on file at Schoolcraft.**

For an immediate hold, please turn this form into the Financial Aid office in person. Submitting this form by email/upload does not guarantee approval and is not processed immediately. If you are approved for a payment postponement, it will not be in place until you see "Received" on the CCG Payment Postponement in Ocelot Access – Financial Aid – Required Documents. Until it shows Received, the postponement is not in place and you may not be held in your classes.

If this form is approved, I understand that:

- this form will NOT be accepted if Schoolcraft does NOT have my 2026-27 FAFSA on file with all Verification completed (*if Verification is required*). \*
- my class(es) will be held temporarily for the Fall 2026 semester only. This hold only waives the upfront payment requirement on tuition and fees and does not make funding available at the bookstore.
- I am financially responsible for all charges and that they must be paid in full by the indicated semester date to remain enrolled. Payment must be in the form of approved financial aid and/or cash, check, or credit card. If you make any payments on your account, any eligible refunds will not go out until the semester refund dates.
- It is my responsibility to drop from all my classes if I am unable to pay for them. It is also my responsibility to know the dates that apply to my classes.

- if I become ineligible for financial aid or if financial aid does not cover the entire cost of registration, then I am responsible for any balance owed to the college.
- if I do not complete my file by submitting any and all required documentation, I will be responsible for the entire balance of tuition, fees, and books billed to my account.

- I will NOT be awarded Community College Guarantee until I have submitted proof of my High School Graduation (**the preferred method is by submitting final high school transcripts through Parchment**).

## Community College Guarantee Eligibility Requirements for 2026 High School Graduates

- Be a MI Resident since July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025 (for dependent students, this applies to Parent residency status)
- Be a U.S. Citizen, Permanent Resident, or Approved Refugee
- Graduate from a Michigan High School (with diploma, certificate of completion, or high school equivalency)
- Submit proof of Michigan high School completion to Schoolcraft College
- Be a Regularly Admitted Student to Schoolcraft (not guest or dual enrolled student status)
- Be enrolled full time (12+ credits) in a semester to receive funding
- Maintaining Satisfactory Academic Progress to maintain funding in subsequent semesters (GPA 2.0, 67% completion rate, under 90 earned credits)
