I. Creativity

- Presentation consists of clearly original and innovative ideas, content, and activities that highlight the unique attributes of the topic.

II. Visuals

- Presentation's visual organization includes easy to follow queues, prompts, etc. that appeal to attendees and enhance their grasp of the topic.

III. Content

- Presentation/activity includes multiple content types: text, images, video, demonstration showpiece, live action, audience participation, etc.
- Presentation's organization allows the audience to readily understand the material and retain the key points.
