This 2-week, 100-hour course is presented by Western Wayne County S.O.T. Consortium and Schoolcraft College. The course is designed to certify officers as S.W.A.T. Team Operators. Students will be instructed in how to resolve critical incidents involving a threat to public safety which otherwise exceed the capabilities of traditional law enforcement first responders, and/or investigative units. Topics to be taught will include, but are not limited to:

- Building clearing techniques
- · Drug raid tactics & planning
- Use of chemical agents & protective mask
- Diversionary devices
- · Tactical shooting & weapon training
- Live fire training

- Hostage negotiations
- · Less lethal technology
- · Tactics of containment
- Use of ballistic shields
- Arrest teams
- Armored vehicle tactics

Requirements: Functional clothing and equipment. Attendees should be free from physical/medical conditions

Equipment and Supplies Needed (students supply their own weapons and ammo):

- Department handgun (semi-automatic)
- M-16 / AR15 / M4 (.223 or 5.56 rifle)
- 12-gauge shotgun
- Chemical agents protective mask

- 2,000 rounds for handgun
- 4,000 rounds for .223 / 5.56
- 100 rounds for shotgun "00"
- Attendees are responsible for their own lunch
