Trainees will refamiliarize with emergency vehicle operation, new vehicle technology (electronic stabilization and traction assist), legalities, liabilities, policies, and procedures.

There will be a one-hour lunch break. Attendees are responsible for their own lunch.

Attendees are required to bring a police vehicle for this training. One police vehicle is needed for every three department attendees.
