Anywhere from 60%-80% of officer involved shootings occur during low-light engagements. Officers are required to identify lethal threats before engaging, regardless of the lighting conditions. Therefore, officers need to train and become proficient with low-light tactics. This course is designed to give officers a tactical advantage in low-light engagements.
