General Information for RN Degree Completion Students:

- ▶ A maximum of 74 credits may be transferred from community college/s (credits granted for prior learning are not included in this total)
- ▶ All prior learning credits granted to a student based on RN licensure will be placed on the student's transcript after he/she has earned 12 credits at Madonna University. There will be one small fee for this transcription (currently \$50).
- ▶ A minimum of 30 credits must be earned by taking Madonna University courses
- ▶ A total of 124 credits is required for graduation with a BSN degree from Madonna University
- ▶ Only courses with a grade of "C" or better will transfer
- ▶ Science courses with a grade of C or better will be transferred from accredited colleges regardless of completion dates
- ▶ Prior learning credit will be granted for 29 credits of nursing (Med/Surg, Pharm, OB/Peds, Psyc/Mental Health) based on RN licensure, without further exams
- ▶ Prior learning credit will also be granted when transferrable credits are not available for Anatomy & Physiology, Microbiology, and Nutrition, based on RN licensure, without further exams
- ▶ Several Madonna University general education requirements may be fulfilled by satisfying the MACRAO Agreement at Schoolcraft College. Students desiring to pursue this option should first consult with a counselor at Schoolcraft College, and then discuss the options with the nursing admission counselor or degree completion coordinator at Madonna University
- ▶ An option is offered to take the theory portion of all nursing courses on-line. There are also increasing opportunities to take some of the general education courses on-line, and by other distance learning modalities
- ▶ RNs with significant experience in community health and/or leadership may elect to apply for prior learning credit for theory and/or practicum components of other selected nursing courses

Admission Requirements:

- ▶ A current Michigan RN license
- ▶ A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 from all colleges and/or other post secondary educational institutions
- ▶ One year of each of the following in high school, or one semester of each at the college level, with a grade of C or higher: algebra, biology, chemistry

Applicants who do not meet admission criteria are encouraged to contact the Degree Completion Coordinator to discuss alternate ways to fulfill these requirements
