The Continuing Education and Professional Development Department of Schoolcraft College, with generous financial support by the Bosch Community Fund, the Rockall Fund and the PPL Community Outreach Fund is pleased to announce that scholarship funds are available for Kids on Campus Summer 2022.

For your application to be complete, please include:

- KOC Application Form
- KOC Registration and Emergency Form

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling weekly basis until the funds are exhausted. Please select your three top camps. We will try to honor your first choice but may not be able to do so if a camp is full. The scholarship will cover the costs of one camp per person.

So that we can share the excitement that KOC brings to campers with our donors, recipients of a scholarship are required to share their experience in some way. Examples of ways a camper can share their experience include: taking a photo of a camp project and telling about their experience, a letter summarizing the camp they participated in and what they learned, an art piece, or a video from camp. Completed projects should be turned in the last day of camp to the KOC Headquarters in the Biomedical Technology building, room 167 or to Before and After Care in the Liberal Arts Building, room LA440.

Families of awarded students will be contacted by e-mail within two weeks of receipt of the application.

Scholarship Application Form

Scholarship funds have been provided by the Bosch Community fund, Rockall Fund and PPL Community Outreach Fund. Application forms are reviewed by the PPL staff responsible for children's programming. Award decisions are made on a case by case basis. Criteria considered are the family's financial need and the child's interest in attending a KOC amp. Only one scholarship per student can be awarded. Information submitted on the application form is strictly confidential.
