For your application to be complete, please include:

- KOC Application Form

Applications will be reviewed on a rolling weekly basis until the funds are exhausted. Please select your top three camps. We will try to honor your first choice but may not be able to do so if a camp is full. The scholarship will cover the costs of one camp per person.

So that we can share the excitement that KOC brings to campers with our donors, recipients of a scholarship are required to share their experience in some way. Examples of ways a camper can share their experience include: taking a photo of a camp project and telling about their experience, a letter summarizing the camp they participated in and what they learned, an art piece, or a video from camp. Completed projects should be turned in on the last day of camp to the KOC Headquarters in the Biomedical Technology building, room 167 or to Before and After Care in the Liberal Arts Building, room LA440.

Families of awarded students will be contacted via e-mail within two weeks of receipt of the application.
