





Navigating Your eCourse on a Computer

After logging into your account, click on your course tile from the 'Home' page.




Click the red 'Click Here' button.






Click Enter.



Your course will open in a new window. If the introductory video doesn't begin automatically, press the play button in the video window. **Make sure you have the volume turned up!**

When the video ends, the forward button will turn red and allow you to move to the next page.






Navigating the eCourse


The course will not advance automatically. You must use the navigation bar at the bottom of the screen to move forward once it starts blinking red.



Click the 'Settings' button in the lower right corner:

- Select 'Help' to view additional layout and navigation details
- access the course glossary
- change the course language
