

## Michigan Transfer Agreement Requirements 2022-2023

Students at Schoolcraft can transfer to an MTA-receiving four-year college or university, and satisfy their lower level general education requirements by completing MTA. The course requirements below must be completed with a 2.0 or higher, and at least 1 credit of MTA-coursework must be completed at Schoolcraft for the College to grant the endorsement. Occupational courses do not qualify.

### What are the Michigan Transfer Agreement Requirements?

Mathematics	4	Select one mathematics course from the following categories: College Algebra, Quantitative Reasoning, or Advanced Level Mathematics
