

## FULFILL THE MICHIGAN TRANSFER AGREEMENT (MTA) WITH ONLINE COURSES & FREE OPEN EDUCATION RESOURCES (OERS)!

With the MTA, you select general education courses that transfer to participating four-year Michigan institutions. The “Online + OER Options” offer you flexibility with online courses and cost savings with free OER textbooks.

The chart below specifies each general education distribution area and related course requirement(s). In each area, the “Online + OER Options” identify online courses that use free OERs.

*Courses marked with an \* can only count in one distribution area.*

*Refer to the current tuition and fees schedule for other costs that may apply.*

### DISTRIBUTION AREA

### COURSE REQUIREMENTS

English Composition:  
3 credit hours

Select one MTA course: ENG 101, ENG 102, ENG 221

**Online + OER Options:** ENG 101, ENG 102

English Composition or  
Communications: 3 credit hours

Select a second MTA course in English Composition:  
ENG 101, ENG 102, ENG 221

**OR**

Select one MTA course in Communication Arts\*: COMA 103, COMA 200, COMA 202, COMA 212, or COMA 240

**Online + OER Options:** COMA 103\*, ENG 101, ENG 102

Note: A COMA course can satisfy one distribution area only.

Humanities: 4 to 8 credit hours

Select two MTA courses from two different disciplines.

**Online + OER Options:** ART 201, COMA 103\*, HIST 134\*, HIST 137\*, HIST 151\*, HIST 152\*, HIST 153\*, HUM 106, HUM 212, PHIL 247

Mathematics: 4 to 5 credit hours

Select at least one MTA course from the following:

MATH 111 Applications – Utility of Math, MATH 122 Statistics, MATH 126 College Algebra, or advanced level course in any of these areas.

**Online + OER Options:** MATH 111, MATH 122

Natural Sciences:  
7 to 9 credit hours

Select two MTA science courses, with one course containing a lab, from two different disciplines.

**Online + OER Options:** CHEM 104, CHEM 111, PHYS 104, PHYS 123

Social Sciences:  
6 to 8 credit hours

Select two MTA courses from two different disciplines.

**Online + OER Options:** HIST 134\*, HIST 137\*, HIST 151\*, HIST 152\*, HIST 153\*, POLS 105, PSYCH 201, PSYCH 229, PSYCH 249, SOC 201

Total Credits: Minimum of  
30 credit hours required

Electives may be selected from MTA courses
