

Emergency Medical Technology: Paramedic Program

The emergency medical technology paramedic program prepares students for employment as pre-hospital advanced emergency medical providers-Paramedic. A combination of lecture, laboratory, and clinical and field experience will be utilized to accomplish all training requirements.

Students who successfully complete the program requirements, will be eligible to take the National Registry of EMT, Paramedic written and practical exams. Those who successfully pass the credentialing exams will be eligible for licensure in the State of Michigan as a Paramedic. Licensed Paramedics are in high demand within both the State of Michigan, as well as many other states. See chart below for program completion, NREMT success, and Positive Career Placement numbers.
