- 4. The Student Accounts Office will drop the student and/or place the student's account on hold, assess a returned check fee, and follow standard collection procedures.

- 1. The Student Accounts Office will notify the student.
- The Student Accounts Office will drop the student and/or place the student's account on hold, assess a returned check fee and follow standard collection procedures.
