
## **Description**



Paddle the Industrial Channel of the Rouge River beginning at Melvindale's Kessey Field House and ending at Belanger Park in River Rouge on the Detroit River. See the original Ford Rouge Complex, one of a kind drawbridges and the new Gordie Howe International Bridge. There is a \$50 boat rental fee that includes shuttle service. There is a \$15 service charge if you are bringing your own boat. Participants bringing their own boat, must have a double hulled kayak and personal flotation device (PFD).


