

#### **Program Description**

The Alternative Route to Interim Teacher Certification (ARC) Program is a Michigan Department of Education approved teacher preparation program allowing individuals to obtain initial certification in elementary education (grades PK-3 or 3-6), or add endorsements to a current teaching certificate.

A PK-3 or 3-6 Elementary Interim Teaching Certificate (ITC) is earned upon completion of pre-certification coursework, passing of appropriate MTTC, and successful background check. The ITC enables program participants to work as certified PK-3 or 3-6 or Elementary classroom teachers in Michigan's public, charter, and parochial classrooms. A Standard Teaching Certificate is earned upon completion of the following: three (3) years of successful teaching under the ITC, instructional support from Schoolcraft College (peer mentoring and instructional coaching), and completion of additional program requirements.

#### **Application Requirements**

The Alternative Route to Interim Teacher Certification (ARC) program requires an ARC Program application (attached). To be admitted to the program you must complete the following:

2.	Transcripts	It is recommended you request official undergraduate transcripts from all colleges and universities previously attended. Transcripts must be sent directly from the issuing college or university to Schoolcraft College. To confirm that transcripts have been received, contact the Answer Center at 734-462-4426.
3.	Apply to the ARC Program	Apply to the ARC program by completing the program specific application. Email the application to <a href="mailto:arc@schoolcraft.edu">arc@schoolcraft.edu</a> .
4.	Credential Evaluation	Contact the Education Office, <a href="mailto:arc@schoolcraft.edu">arc@schoolcraft.edu</a> , to make an appointment to have your degree, MTTC, and (if applicable) credentials assessed.
		This program requires students to possess a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university (with a minimum overall GPA of 3.0), successfully pass the applicable MTTC Subject Area Test(s)*, and pass the Criminal Background check.
		*Probationary approval maybe given without passage of MTCC Subject Area Test(s) for one academic year.
5.	Register for EDUC Courses	Meet with the ARC Certification Officer to plan your EDUC courses as needed.

#### **Criminal Records Check:**

Schoolcraft College will complete a criminal background check, without fingerprinting, during the application process.

Sections 1230 and 1230a of the Revised School Code require school districts to conduct a State Police and Federal Bureau of Investigation criminal records check for all new teachers, school administrators, school counselors, school psychologists, school nurses, and school social workers employed. A person may be immediately employed if a criminal records check has been requested and the individual has signed an oath regarding their conviction status.

Background checks must be completed before an applicant can be employed by a local school district, ISD or PSA. An applicant is responsible for payment of fees for a background check requested through the program director.


