<p>1. As part of the College's Strategic Plan, the administration renovated and expanded the Vistatech Center. Under Institutional Effectiveness, this has allowed for the completion of existing maintenance needs as well as increase the capacity of third party rentals with the addition of a multipurpose Innovation Center, a revitalized American Harvest, and the addition of a Brew Pub. It also has increased Student Success & Engagement as the Innovation Center is now able to house many traditional and PPL courses and outreach activities. Highlighting the Culinary Arts and Brewing and Distillation Programs in their newly updated state of the art spaces has brought additional light and excitement to these programs, effectively bolstering our enrollment in both programs.</p> <p>In addition, the College is adding a new Development Component Unit (DCU) to the North parking lot, which will serve to bolster existing programs through experiential learning while also increasing alternative revenue streams.</p> <p>As such, the need for additional parking to satisfy increased demand at Vistatech as well as replace lost parking from the new DCU development has necessitated us increasing parking to the west of Vistatech.
