



Emergency Medical Technology: Paramedic Program

The Emergency Medical Technology – Paramedic program is designed to prepare students for professional roles as pre-hospital advanced emergency medical providers. To ensure comprehensive training and meet all regulatory requirements, the curriculum integrates several instructional methods:

- **Didactic Lecture:** Theoretical foundations of emergency medicine.
- **Practical Laboratory:** Hands-on skill development in a controlled environment.
- **Clinical & Field Experience:** Real-world application of skills in hospital and emergency response settings.

Upon successful completion of the program, students qualify to sit for the **National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT)** Paramedic written and practical examinations. Attaining this national credential serves as the gateway to licensure within the State of Michigan.

Currently, licensed Paramedics are experiencing high demand both locally and nationally. The following data highlights our program's recent performance in student success and workforce integration:
