Measure 3: Candidate Competency at Program Completion

As an Educator Preparation Provider, we are required to ensure that teacher candidates are knowledgeable of pedagogy and the subject matter they intend to teach in the classroom. To demonstrate that knowledge, aspiring teachers must pass the appropriate Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) for the subject matter(s) they wish to teach.

% Pass = Percent of eligible test takers who passed the test. This refers to the percentage of all test takers who passed the test during the program year. This data reflects the cumulative pass rates, including initial attempts and retakes. Each test taker is counted once.

Interpretive Cautions

The candidates for whom results are presented in this document may not reflect the same proportion of all the types and capabilities of candidates in the population who will take this test in the future. Extreme caution should be used in interpreting data for small numbers (<100) of candidates, as such data may not provide a valid indication of how candidates typically perform. Results reported for only a small number of candidates may not be indicative of how large numbers of candidates typically perform.

Analysis

Schoolcraft College has a cumulative pass rate of 80.7% for the licensure tests. Nineteen of Schoolcraft College's represented programs have a 90% or higher MTTC pass rate. Seventeen programs have cumulative pass rates above the state average. For programs with lower pass rates, students are supported with resources and tutoring through the College's Learning Support Services department.
