

State-by-State Professional Licensure Disclosures

Some Schoolcraft College academic programs are designed to prepare students to apply for applicable licensure or certification in the State of Michigan. For such programs, federal regulations require Schoolcraft College to disclose information regarding the state(s) where the program (or course) completion satisfies those requirements and where it does not. These public disclosure requirements apply to all programs regardless of their modality (i.e. on-ground, online, and hybrid programs). States vary in what professions they require to be licensed and how licensure is acquired. Some states require an individual to graduate from an accredited program. Others require individuals to obtain additional coursework, additional fieldwork, background checks, finger printing, drug screening, passage of additional state licensing exams, additional fees, or other requirements.

Schoolcraft College makes every effort to ensure state licensure and certification information is current; however, state requirements may change. If you plan to pursue licensure or certification in a state other than Michigan, please contact the applicable licensing board(s) in the state where you may want to pursue licensure or certification before beginning an academic program to verify whether a program meets educational requirements for licensure or certification in that state.

PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE DISCLOSURE POLICY

In accordance with federal requirements, and as a [State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement](#) participating institution, Schoolcraft College will provide public and direct Professional Licensure Disclosure Statements as set forth in this policy. Professional Licensure Disclosure Statements are defined as announcements/notifications by the College that provide information publicly or, when indicated, by directly notifying students whether a specific academic program aligns with professional licensure education requirements for the state in which a prospective student resides, or a currently enrolled student is located (see Student Location definition below).

Policy: During the admission process, prospective or current students requesting entry into a program in a licensure field, will receive notification prior to admission if the program does not lead to licensure in their location or if the institution has not decided whether the program leads to licensure in their location. Students currently enrolled in a licensure program as of July 1st, 2024, and located outside of Michigan will receive notification within 14 days.

Student Location

For this policy's purposes, student location is determined to be the state where the student is located based on their address in the Student Information System. It is the student's responsibility to inform the program director if the student's location changes during enrollment in the program to ensure authorization and licensure eligibility requirements are met.

The information in the table linked below does not guarantee that the professional licensure/certification authority will approve a student’s application. Other requirements for professional licensure or certification may exist; therefore, the course or program may or may not provide the aligned requirements and does not guarantee professional licensure/certification.
